As part of South Sudan is wrecked by famine and Nigeria, Somalia, and Yemen are on the brink, United Nations agricultural chief José Graziano de Silva issued a critical warning:



Sabaad's struggle is felt by so many others throughout the regions experiencing this hunger crisis. In one community in South Sudan, when Oxfam relief teams arrived, families had been boiling tree leaves in water because it was their only option for food.
