HOW IT WORKS

We offer full-time immersive programs, long-form courses and short-term classes and workshops taught by skilled practitioners that prepare our students to tackle the greatest technological, business and design challenges of the 21st century by offering practical, realworld, hands-on training.



WHAT WE OFFER

- » *Immersives* are 8-12 week, full-time programs that offer students the opportunity to learn fundamentals, create a portfolio, and interact with experts in their field. Students emerge from these programs prepared for roles as junior-level Rails developers and user experience designers.
- » *Courses* are long-form offerings which allow for a more comprehensive understanding of specific topics for individuals looking to level up, increase their earning potential, change jobs, or even help to spur a career change.
- » *Classes* are focused sessions designed to provide basic essentials, practical insights and tactical approaches for those who are looking to scratch the surface of a particular topic.
- » *Workshops* offer deeper exploration of a particular topic, and often include break-out sessions, case studies, live programming and prototyping to accelerate learning and proficiency.

We also offer an online learning option that is accessible anywhere with an Internet connection, through *Front Row*, General Assembly's monthly subscription service featuring on-demand instructional videos and unlimited access to interactive live streams.

Through our *Enterprise Program*, General Assembly also works with companies that are looking to introduce their employees to emerging technologies and entrepreneurial thinking through hands-on, meaningful lessons on the latest trends and best practices in technology, business, and design.
